Administrative Changes Impacting the State of New Mexico's Disability Program

Purpose

In order to improve efficiency and accuracy in the administration of the State of New Mexico's Disability Program, this Letter of Administration is issued to provide notice of the following important changes:

Administrative Changes with the Disability Program

As of April 1, 2014 the following administrative changes will go into effect:

- FOR LONG-TERM DISABILITY CLAIMANTS: Effective April 1, 2014 Long-Term Disability (LTD) claimants will only receive monthly benefit payments via direct deposit. A direct deposit authorization form is attached to this Benefits Administration Letter so that LTD claimants currently receiving paper checks by mail can make the necessary process change. To ensure continuity of benefits the completed form must be faxed to CompuSys/Erisa at (512) 597- 4692 no later than March 21, 2014;
- FOR SHORT-TERM DISABILITY CLAIMANTS: In the event a participant leaves employment, or a participating Local Public Body separates from the State's Group Benefits Plan, individual claimants must continue to make required premium contributions to maintain eligibility. Each month's premium payment must be made by cashier's check, mailed to the address below, and post-marked by the 20th day of each month.
