# Premium Only Plan (POP)

Benefits are deducted from pay as a pre-tax deduction

# Disability Overview Administered by Erisa Administrative Services, Inc.

100% Paid for by the employee

# Short Term Disability (STD)

Up to 6 months following 28 day elimination period

# Long Term Disability (LTD)

Up to 18 months following 6 months of STD

Can enroll at anytime due to benefit premium taken as an after -tax deduction

# To be eligible for disability, an employee must:

- Be enrolled in the SoNM Disability Plan
- Have paid disability premiums for at least 12 consecutive months, and suffer a disabling, non-work-related illness or injury that prevents the employee from working in any capacity.



# Active Enrollment-2021 is an opportunity for benefiteligible employees to:

- Switch/Enroll or Drop Medical; add/drop Dental, Vision, and/or Disability
- Life Insurance Increase or Add Life Insurance for Dependent Child(ren)
  - Dependent Children coverage does not require an EOI
  - Supplemental Life:
     Employee: Currently enrolled employees can increase coverage by one increment (\$10,000) up to \$150,000
  - Spouse/Domestic Partner: Can increase coverage by one increment (\$10,000) up to \$30,000
  - Any amount over \$10K or over the guaranteed amount will require EOI

# 2022 Plan Year Changes

# SoNM Active Enrollment-2021

This year's annual Open Enrollment will require <u>all</u> benefit-eligible State and Local Public Body employees to actively examine the benefits offered for calendar year 2022. This is to ensure employees are making the appropriate decisions about the benefits that will best suite their own-and their families-needs.

Benefit- eligible State and Local Public Body employees will be asked to submit either:

Enrollment/Change Form

or not.

•No Change Form-whether changes will be made to their benefit elections for calendar year 2022

Exception: New Hires hired in 2021 No supporting Documentation Required

# Supporting Documentation

Members are being asked to submit (or resubmit) proof of dependency for each dependent.

- This means proof of dependency documentation must be submitted with the No Change or Enrollment/Change Form for any dependent continuing coverage, or starting coverage for the first time.
- In addition, a new life insurance Beneficiary Designation Form must also be submitted.

# Supporting Documentation

This information should be sent in along with the enrollment form by October 31, 2021

### **Adding a Spouse:**

Marriage Certificate (must be court-filed and show filing date/acceptance; Marriage Licenses are not acceptable)



### **Adding a Domestic Partner:**

Signed and notarized Domestic Partnership form (note: must be 12 or more months since any prior identified domestic partnership or marriage)

### **Adding a Dependent Child:**

Birth Certificate
Court Issued Guardianship/Kinship Papers
Court Issued Custodial Papers (must not have expired)
Adoption Papers

### **Adding your Domestic Partner's Children:**

Birth Certificate or similar court-issued paperwork as described above identifying your domestic partner as the parent or legal guardian
